We've decluttered the space, allowing non-mobile children ample room to explore safely. The addition of diverse light sources, aromatic scents, and a variety of sounds has created a stimulating and inviting atmosphere. We're delighted to report that this revamped area is a resounding success!

Main Hall Reconfiguration In response to the unique needs of our children, we've divided the main hall into two distinct zones. This strategic division ensures that each child can utilize the space effectively. Despite the reduction in individual room size, the children are engaging with their environment more peacefully and with greater purpose. Enhanced access to resources and the implementation of clear labels empower the children to express their preferences and engage with the resources they desire.

Become a First Steps Trustee






